

Resident Council Mission Statement

(As developed during an initial meeting on 8/23/99)

We, the Resident Council of the University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey – New Jersey Medical School, aim to improve the quality of resident education, facilitate communication and act as liaison between residents and the Graduate Medical Education Committee, inform residents of their individual program educational requirements, and to appoint members, as sub-committee, to participate in residency review sessions.

Meetings are held quarterly with officer elections held during the final meeting of the year. A president, vice-president, secretary, treasurer, and a resident representative to the GME committee are elected. The president and GME elected member will attend GME meetings monthly.

Members of the resident council will be elected by their peers in the first week of June before the start of the New Year. Two members will be elected by each residency program and will be required to attend meetings quarterly meetings.

The resident council will address issues related to the mission statement and bring them to GME for resolution.
