



Faculty Nomination Form

Membership in the Graduate Faculty is based on ability to participate in graduate education and research. There are three categories of membership related to the individual's involvement in graduate education and affiliation with UMDNJ.

In reviewing the qualifications of proposed Members, the Executive Council is particularly interested in their scholarly contributions to biomedical sciences. The principal evidence of research accomplishment is publication in journals and books for which the acceptance of manuscripts is determined by recognized scholars exercising independent judgment. Prior involvement in graduate education also is considered.

MEMBERSHIP

Member -

Members conduct graduate courses and guide research as chairpersons or members of students' advisory or examination committees. They also participate in Graduate Faculty meetings, exercise voting privileges, serve on committees of the Graduate School, and are collectively responsible for academic policy in graduate studies. Members must hold full faculty rank at UMDNJ. Members must have an active, productive research program or have made significant contributions to research and have offered or participated in courses for graduate students.

Associate Member -

Individuals holding a faculty rank who do not qualify for Member status may be appointed as an Associate Member and fully participate in the graduate teaching programs except as a mentor for a Ph.D. candidate. They are not eligible to be a member of the Executive Council. The Associate Member will have all other privileges and vote at faculty meetings.

Adjunct Member -

Individuals who have exceptional scholarly research and/or educational accomplishments, but do not hold academic title in one of the Basic Science Departments at UMDNJ, may be considered for appointment to the Graduate Faculty as Adjunct Member. Adjunct Members may offer graduate courses, but cannot be a member of the Executive Council nor vote at faculty meetings. They may serve as members on dissertation/thesis Advisory Committees, but not as a mentor or chairperson of the committee.

PROCEDURES

The Department Chair or Program Director, following approval, submits nominations by the Graduate Faculty of the candidate's department. Submit this form with the candidate's curriculum vitae, listing full publications, to the appropriate campus GSBS-Associate Deans Office. Following approval by the Executive Council, the candidate's will be forwarded to the Dean of the Graduate School.
